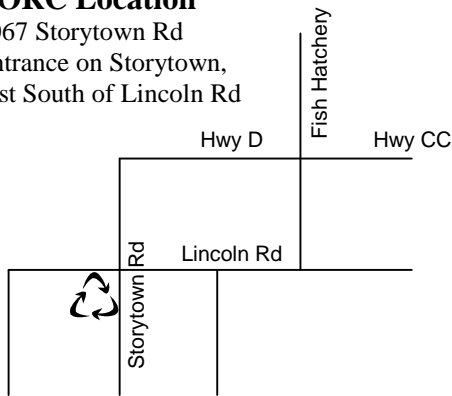


The Town of Oregon Recycling Center (TORC) is a complete recycling and waste disposal site for all Town of Oregon residents.

TORC Location

1067 Storytown Rd
Entrance on Storytown,
Just South of Lincoln Rd



TORC Hours

Saturday (year round)
7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Wednesday (May 1 – November 1)
2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Admittance

For admittance to the TORC you must purchase a punch card. Punch cards are available at the town hall or TORC. **As of Jan. 1, 2012 vehicles will no longer be required to have an admittance sticker.** You are required to provide a punch card as proof of residency.

Cost

There is a charge for all non-recyclable waste. Cash or checks only (no credit cards). **As of Jan. 1, 2012, payment must be made using a punch card – payment per bag is NOT accepted.**

The TORC will accept for a fee washers, dryers and stoves.

As of Jan. 1, 2012, payment must be made using a punch card – payment per bag is NOT accepted.

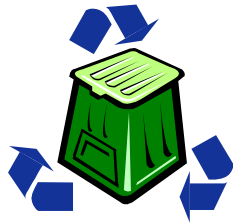

YARD WASTE

Yard Waste is free and accepted at the TORC.

Leaves and grass clippings – Put any compostable material in the compost pile at the site. Always dispose of the plastic bags (or other container) in the trash or appropriate site.

Brush and wood – The TORC only takes brush and wood that are free of soil. We also take clean, unpainted and untreated lumber at the burn pile. We cannot take stumps or painted/treated lumber.



Wood Chips – The TORC may have wood chips available for residents on a first come, first serve basis. The wood chips are free. However, starting Jan. 1, 2012 if anyone would require help loading wood chips there will be a fee of \$2.00 or 1 punch.

You must have a punch card with you when dropping off yard waste and recyclables at the TORC. Even though you are not charged for yard waste or recyclables, the punch card is proof of residency.

GARBAGE

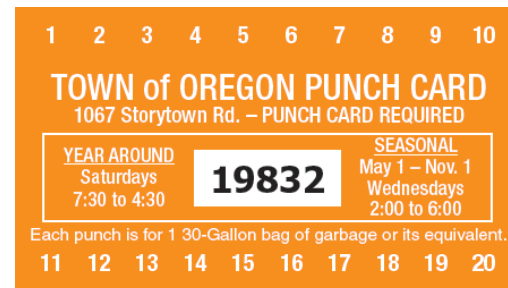
The TORC charges fees for all non-recyclable waste. **As of January 1, 2012 fees will increase.** This increase is due to a decrease in funds received from the state recycling grant and an increase in operational expenses.

DO NOT BRING...TVs, air conditioners, computers, refrigerators, microwaves**

Payment

As of January 1, 2012, payment **MUST** be made with a punch card. A punch card costs \$40 and contains 20 punches. Each punch is worth \$2.00. Punch cards never expire.



RECYCLE

All recyclables are free and should be put in the all-in-one recycling dumpster.

Accepted Item:

- Cardboard*
- Catalogs
- Cereal and Cracker boxes
- Computer paper
- Envelopes
- Holiday gift wrapping paper
- Juice boxes and other drink packages
- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Office paper
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper grocery bags
- Paper milk and juice cartons
- Phone books
- Pizza boxes (no food or grease)
- Aluminum cans and aluminum pie plates
- Empty aerosol cans
- Glass bottles and jars (all colors)
- Tin/Steel cans
- All plastic bottles (no motor oils)
- Plastic containers #1-7

Non-Recyclable Items:

- Deli containers
- Frozen food containers
- Microwave dinner plates
- Plastic Bags
- Plastic film, wrap or Styrofoam

* There is a separate dumpster for cardboard only. Please flatten cardboard boxes, cereal boxes and other large items to make room.
